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SPARKLING WINE

- Passaparola Prosecco Spumante. DOC Friuli, Italy. 11% (vg)** £23
A fine Prosecco with subtle pear and brioche on the nose followed by a crisp palate of succulent apple, biscuit and pear. Gently foamy, with a delicate finish.
- Domaine des Baumard, Cremant de Loire Rose. Loire, France 12.5% (v)** £30
A very fine, pale pink hue, the nose is enticing, full of peachy fresh fruit, nuanced with early tinges of honeycomb, and some red fruits sprinkled with mint. Absolutely packed with vivacious fruits held up by a lively acidity.
- Champagne Pierre Mignon, 1er Cru, Grande Reserve. France. 12% (vg)** £45
Our excellent 'house' Champagne. Pale yellow colour. Fresh breadly aromas, rounded orchard fruits, brioche, with a fresh apple like freshness on the palate.

WHITE WINES

CRISP / LIGHT-BODIED

- 2019 Pinot Grigio delle Venezie Uvam IGT, Veneto, Italy. 12% (vg)** £20
This premier Pinot Grigio has wonderful floral aroma's, on the palate there's an abundance of tropical fruit, melon, guava and peach with zippy acidity making it so fresh & moreish.
- 2019 Picpoul de Pinet, Domaine Montredon, Languedoc, France. 13% (vg)** £23
This lovely and fresh Picpoul has plentiful aromas of grapefruit and citrus fruit as well as bracing citrus & stone fruit flavours.
- 2019 Funkstille Gruner Veltliner. Austria. 12% (vg)** £23
With its subtle exotic hints, ripe pear and fresh citrus flavours, it's a dry wine with complex flavours. The palate is rich with flavours of melon and grapefruit with a refreshing, zippy finish.
- 2019 Muscadet Sur Lie. Domaine Herbauges. Loire, France. 12% (vg)** £23
Bright and deep purple colour. Aromas of black fruit reminiscent of fresh plum mixed with graphite notes. On the palate the wine is balanced and energetic, with sweet and round tannins and a long finish.
- 2019 La Guardiense, Calvese Falanghina Sannio DOP, Campania, Italy. 13.5%** £25
Straw-yellow colour, with the characteristic fruity bouquet that this varietal produces. This wine is fresh and fruity along with a pleasant and mineral profile.

ESOTERIC SPAIN...

- 2019 Silga Verdejo. Rueda, Spain. 12.5% (vg)** £23
Beautiful green-fruit aromas combine with a hint of citrus fruits to give a fresh and vibrant nose. Fresh, varietal-fruit with citrus notes and excellent acidity.
- 2019 Vina Barradero Blanco. Condado de Hueva, Spain. 12.5% (vg) (o)** £25
This is a fine and elegant wine, with vast aromatic range from citrus fruits like grapefruit and orange through to floral notes and blossom and tropical fruits like peach and pineapple.
- 2018 Albariño, Pazo Senorans. Rais Baixas, North-West Spain. 13.5% (vg)** £32
"Pazo de Senorans is considered one of the handful of top estates in Rias-Baixas and has consistently produced some of the best Albariños that money can buy." - Robert Parker.
- 2018 Principa Mathematica. Penedes, Spain. 12.5% (vg) (o)** £35
This Xarel-lo grape, comes from the Alemany i Corrio winery in Catalunya. Fabulous texture with lots of citrus and a really long finish.

MID-WEIGHT / FLAVOURSOME / ENERGY

- 2019 Sophie Te'Blanche Sauvignon Blanc. Elgin, South Africa 13% (vg) (o)** £23
Floral notes with a complex medley of tropical fruits, mingled with subtle lime and gooseberry undertones. The palate is balanced and rich, showing cut green apples with great minerality and texture.
- 2019 Riesling 'The Courtesan'. Clare Valley, South Australia. 12% (vg)** £23
Bolt fresh & bone dry, this modern take on Riesling has oodles of fresh lime, grapefruit, ripe melon and quince character, vibrant, juicy & refreshing.
- 2018 Cotes du Rhone Blanc, Domaine Gonnet, Southern Rhone. 13% (vg) (o)** £25
Grapefruit, citrus oil, white floral notes, a highly expressive and complex nose, rounded, textured, citrus oil, medium-bodied kept fresh by fine acidity & minerality in the mouth. Long, soft orchard fruit finish.
- 2019 Zephyr Sauvignon Blanc. Marlborough, New Zealand. 13% (vg)** £27
A pale green colour, it is showing lime peel, blossom and snow peas on the nose. Lemongrass, melon, fennel seed and lime on the palate. This shows classic Dillon's Point characteristics.
- 2018 Two Rivers 'Juliet' Riesling. Marlborough, New Zealand. 11.5%** £28
Aromas of lemon honey, dried apricots, a subtle aniseed & floral notes. The palate is delicate & pur with pithy citrus flavours of lemon balm & marmalade finish.

CLASSIC REGIONS

- 2019 Gavi di Gavi DOCG, Olim Bauda, Piedmont, Italy. 12.5% (vg)** £30
Possessing a striking energy and fullness while avoiding any sense of heaviness, this Fine Gavi di Gavi shows notes of yellow stone fruits, crushed rocks, mint & rosemary wrap around the persistent, mineral finish.
- 2019 Pouilly-Fume 'Argile a S. Domaine Chatellier, Loire, France. 13% (vg)** £33
Old vine Sauvignon Blanc raised in the famous Silex soils – its high proportion of flint storing & reflecting heat, the resulting ripe fruit balancing a rich flinty minerality that imbues the wine with a delicious complexity.
- 2017 Chablis Domaine Bernard Defaix, Burgundy, France. 12.5% (vg) (o)** £35
A vivacious, lemon curd scented bouquet with plenty of cold stone/granitic aromas coming through with aeration. The mid-weight palate is well balanced with crisp acidity, fine tension & a lingering finish.
- 2018 Sancerre, Les Perrois, Loire, France. 13% (o)** £35
The nose is a lovely blend of refreshing citrus fruit, gooseberry and a distinctive grassy note. The palate further iterates the nose, with a textured mouth-feel of grapefruit, citron & a stony mineral note to the finish.
- 2018 Rully 1er Cru. Domaine Jaeger-Defaix. Burgundy, France. 13.5% (vg) (o)** £45
Aged for 18 months used oak barrels. Aromas of peach, apricot, Churned butter, sea smoke on both nose & palate. A hint of brioche too here & wonderful balanced flavours through to an elegant, nuanced finish.

ROSE WINE

- 2019 La Vie En Rose Cinsault, Languedoc, France. 11.5% (vg)** £20
A delicious, elegant and fresh tasting Rose from the Languedoc region. Raspberry scented. Soft in the mouth with flavours of cherry and grenadine.
- 2019 Provence Rose. Moment Inattendu. Provence, France. 13% (vg)** £26
A fresh and balanced rosé that captures the spirit of the Cote d'Azur with its strawberry and white peach flavours. Crisp, dry, mineral elegance.

RED WINE

RIPE FRUIT / FRUIT-FORWARD

- 2018 Paso Primero, Somontano, Spain. 14% (vg)** £20
Probably the best house red in the world! Spain meets Bordeaux in this full-bodied juicy blend of Merlot & Cabernet Sauvignon. Very tasty, very smooth.
- 2019 Pinot Noir. Calusari, Romania. 12.5% (vg)** £20
A light, soft and welcoming nose of cherry, and sweet mellow spices. Supple & juicy red berry fruit flavours and a lovely elegant finish.
- 2018 Felino Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina. 14% (vg) (o)** £26
Intense black fruits combine with floral aromas. Full-bodied yet fresh tasting. Very plush in the mouth with opulent black fruits, spice and flowers and sweet, polished tannins.
- 2017 Pasotismo. Somontano, Spain. 15% (vg)** £30
The bigger brother to our popular house red - equal parts Merlot, Cabernet-Sauvignon, Syrah and Garnacha, this is barrel fermented and barrel aged. This is a very limited production, with only 1000 bottles available in the UK and was shortlisted for 'Treat Yourself Red' at the 2020 People's Choice Wine Awards.

CLASSIC REGIONS

- 2016 Finca Manzanos Crianza, Rioja, Spain. 13.5% (vg)** £26
This fine Rioja spends 18 months ageing in oak barrels Very expressive and aromatic with mature fruit, clove and white pepper notes. Powerful and savory in the mouth with round tannins and a mellow finish.
- 2016 Chateau Lamothe-Cissac, Haut-Medoc, Bordeaux, France. 13.5% (v)** £30
A traditional style of Bordeaux that has elegance and savory fruit in abundance. 60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 40% Merlot aged for 1 year in barrel. Notes blackcurrant, scented plum, soft spices and subtle vanilla that come through on the well-balanced palate along with gentle tannins, and a lingering finish.
- 2018 Domaine Fichet, Bourgogne, Pinot Noir, Burgundy, France. 12.5% (vg) (o)** £30
Run by brothers Pierre Yves and Olivier, this light to medium bodied wine with red cherries and strawberries has a slight savoury aspect. This is a very good starting point with those unfamiliar with Burgundy or those that know Burgundy and enjoy decent wine at a decent price.
- 2017 Priorat 'Gine Gine', Spain. 15%** £30
A fine introduction to the powerful, characterful reds from the dramatically steep, slate rich vineyards of Priorat. Full-bodied, with concentrated black fruits, mineral and spice aromas and flavours. Old vine Garnacha.
- 2016 Ribera del Duero, Cuvee Cair, Spain. 14% (o)** £30
Black cherry with good depth of colour. An intense nose of fine wood, leather, cigar box, dark chocolate & fruit combine with sweet tannins to produce a beautifully balanced, elegant red wine. Full and powerful on the attack with good balance. A meaty, juicy mouth feel with sweet tannins. Long, lingering finish.
- 2017 Crozes-Hermitage, Les Pierrelles. Northern Rhone, France. 14% (o)** £35
Pristine Syrah from clay, sand & limestone vineyards. All aged in barrels. Notes of graphite, blackberry & ground pepper all flow from the glass, it has a full-bodied richness, beautiful purity, tons of fruit & present, ripe tannin.
- 2017 Shiraz Stella Bella Vineyards. Margaret River, Australia. 14.5% (v) (o)** £35
Mulberries, plum and cherries followed by subtle hints of clove and cinnamon. Plush, round, fine, silky & juicy texture, with good weight in the mouth and intensity of black fruit flavour through to a pretty, salivating finish.
- 2018 Domaine Jaeger-Defaix Rully Premier Cru Clos du Chapitre. 13% (vg) (o)** £47
Clos du Chapitre has long been celebrated as one of the commune's finest sites. Unfurling in the glass with aromas of ripe red cherries, plums and warm spices, it's a medium to full-bodied wine that's alluringly textural and velvety, with a good core of concentrated fruit, fine structuring tannins and sappy acids.

SILKY / STRUCTURE / FINESSE

- 2018 Sangiovese. Bibi Graetz Cassamata Rosso. Tuscany, Italy. 12.5%** £23
A beautiful and elegant representation of Sangiovese with classic notes of dry cherry, currant, and spice, with a medium to full bodied palate and soft agreeable tannins.
- 2017 Mencia. Meyano 'Tres Filas'. Bierzo, Spain. 13.5% (vg)** £27
Cherry red with violet hues. Intense, fresh, elegant nose where red fruit, strawberry and raspberry sensations dominate, as well as floral and violet notes. In the background, very well integrated vanilla, tobacco and minerals. Elegant and silky.
- 2017 Red Jasper Cabernet Franc. Stellenbosch, South Africa. 14% (vg) (o)** £30
Intense & complex on the nose with blackberry & bramble in abundance & subtle hints of dark chocolate, aniseed and spicy tobacco following through onto a perfectly balanced, fine-grained, velvety palate. Hints of dried mint & cinnamon in the finish.
- 2015 Saumur-Champigny. Montee des Roches, Loire, France. 13.5% (o)** £37
An exotic aroma of red currant, dried florals & savoury brown spices. On the palate this is an enveloping, generous and silky-textured Cabernet Franc with very fine tannins and ripe acidity that is perfectly integrated into the supple fruit texture. Finishing pure & long with hints of red berries & cardamom.
- 2015 Sangiovese Monte de Sassi IGP, Borghetto, Tuscany, Italy. 14.5% (vg) (o)** £39
Older vine Sangiovese from 2 vineyard plots, aged for 20 months in French 225l Barrique. The wine is utterly delicious with bright berry definition and just the right level of mellow spice at the back.
A streamlined, supple, juicy and elegant Sangiovese.

MELLOW / AGED CHARACTERISTICS

- 2014 Sangiovese. Salice Salentino Riserva. Puglia, Italy 13.5% (vg)** £23
Hint of leather and spices, vanilla and cherry on the nose, with a soft and fruity palate.
- 2013 Clos de Trias Ventoux Rouge, Ventoux, Southern France. 14% (vg)** £30
Grenache from 80+ year old vines aged a massive 40 months 75% in tank and 25% in barrel, it offers spectacular notes of spice-box, kirsch and liquorice that flow to a full-bodied, decadently textured red that says beautifully fresh and focused. One of my favourite winter reds.
- 2013 Rioja Reserva, Luis Canas, Rioja Alavesa, Spain. 14.5% (vg) (o)** £35
Deep cherry red, clean and bright. Good aromatic intensity with notes of ripe red fruits over a base of elegant balsamic. In the mouth is tasty, mellow, fresh and with fine nuances of sweet fruit.
- 2012 Clos du Mont Olivet Chateauneuf du Pape, Rhone, France. 15%** £45
Aromas of kirsch, black raspberry, smoke, thyme and herbs start off the show. The wine is lush, soft, medium to full bodied and polished. The tannins & textures are elegant & refined. This is really drinking nicely at 7 years of age.
- 2011 Savigny-lès-Beaune 1er Cru Les Serpentières, Burgundy, France. 13%** £45
The delicate 2011 Savigny-les-Beaune 1er Cru Les Serpentières comes from a single parcel of 60-year-old vines Lifted, airy scents of raspberry leaf, blackberry and a touch of soy. The palate is supple & silky. The finish is gentle yet long with a mineral freshness.

POWERFUL / BARREL AGED

- 2016 Pas Curtei, Penedes, Spain. 14% (vg) (o)** £32
A blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon & Cariñena from Penedès that is matured in third-year French oak barrels for 16 months. The rich, intense black fruit flavours are scored with notes of earth mineral, & tobacco leaf turning to more camphor & balsamic like flavours with time in the glass.
- 2017 Coal Pit 'Tiwha' Pinot Noir. Gibbston, Central Otago, New Zealand. 14%** £40
This vintage has a lifted nose of warm spice, flowers and dried herbs. Full-bodied, fresh & supple with notes of vibrant plum & mocha into a warm, savoury finish of wild game & hallmark forest floor characters. Silky, integrated tannins & well-balanced acidity provide the backbone to this impressive Central Otago Pinot Noir.
- 2015 Amarone della Valpolicella Classico, Italy. 15.5% (vg)** £40
The wine's leading aromas revolve around Morello cherry, blackberry, cumin, dark spice & barbecue smoke. In the mouth, this Amarone offers velvety tannins fine texture, with classically rich, mellow flavours.
- 2015 Barolo Cascina Adelaide, Piedmont, Italy. 14.5% (v) (o)** £45
This is a beautiful wine that boasts a delicate and feminine approach. There is pressed rose, dried violet, wild berry, cassis, truffle and tilled earth. Lighter aromas of ash and smoke lift gracefully from the glass. The tannins are silky and long.
- 2016 Paul Hobbs Pinot Noir, Russian River, California, USA. 15% (vg) (o)** £59
Beautifully crafted Pinot Noir from Paul Hobbs top vineyard sources that are defined by both their proximity to the coast and Russian River to allow cool morning, warm afternoon diurnal swings to develop fruit with purity, richness, and elegance.
- 2016 Chateau Gloria. St-Julien, Bordeaux, France. 13.5%** £65
Abundant aromas of cassis, forest floor, tobacco leaf and a vague hint of spicy oak. Ripe for the vintage with excellent texture & a broad mouth-feel. Cassis, graphite, fruitcake notes. It is medium to full-bodied with fine grained tannins. Nicely complex, quite savory & delicious.
